Ascension of the Lord

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend is Mother’s Day; such a debt of gratitude we owe to our mothers who have put so much of themselves into us and have influenced us to be the people we are. Our earthly mothers help us understand the love and care our heavenly mother Mary has for us. I would like to wish all Mothers a happy Mother’s Day.

In the Gospel of Matthew, Jesus exhorts his disciples, saying that the one “who has been trained for the kingdom of heaven is like a master of a house, who brings out of his treasure what is new and what is old.”

At Vatican II, the Council Fathers sought to make the Mass accessible to us all because the “Eucharistic sacrifice is the source and summit of Christian Life.” They brought out the new and the old. In *Sacrosanctum Concilium* they wrote, “In the restoration and promotion of the sacred liturgy, ...full and active participation by all the people is the aim to be considered before all else; for it is the primary and indispensable source from which the faithful are to derive the true Christian spirit (SC #14).” It may come as a surprise that the Council intended for Gregorian chant to be preserved (SC #54). “...other things being equal, [chant] should be given pride of place in liturgical services.” (SC #116).

The Council Fathers saw value of what is old and what is new. They knew that chant, which dates to the earliest centuries of the Church, is particularly suited to Liturgy because of its simplicity and purity. A simple melody accompanies the sacred words and scripture of the Liturgy. Once the simple melodies are learned, everyone can sing along. Chant is not about one voice leading, but all voices becoming one voice. This is a particular expression of the unity that exists in the Liturgy and body of Christ. Chant also fulfills the Church’s desire for “full and active participation” since everyone is encouraged to sing along. Liturgical music should always focus on participation and away from being entertained.

We have begun to introduce a chant setting for the Mass responses at the 5pm and 7:30am Sunday Masses. Jeffrey Morse, a Cambridge educated expert in chant, has been guiding this effort. It is a change from the cantor-led Mass we are used to, but I encourage you to give it a chance because I think two things will happen. First, it will foster full and active participation and second, the simplicity and purity of the chant will lead us deeper into the sublimity of Eucharistic liturgy which is the source and summit of Christian Life. The music at the 9am and 11am Masses will continue as it is.

To learn more, join Jeffrey Morse for a two-day workshop May 29th and 30th at 7pm. Come and learn about this ancient music of the Church and how to sing this living link to Christ and his apostles. You’ll discover why this music still has the power to top the charts, to bring calm and peace, and how it can help usher you into the presence of God.

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

INFANT BAPTISM - Parents and godparents attend one session to prepare to celebrate this sacrament. We encourage parents to attend before the birth or adoption of their child. Please call the Parish Office at least **six weeks prior to the desired Baptism date** to register your child. **Next preparation class** is on **July 22nd, 2018 beginning with mass at 11AM and ending by 2:30PM**. Please call the Parish Office to register. Upcoming baptisms are on **June 10th, July 8th, and August 12, 2018**. Baptisms are scheduled with Father Vincent on the ***second Sunday of the month, after the 11AM Mass***. Parishioners who prefer to have the Baptism at “their” regular mass time may make that request through the parish office.

MARRIAGE - Couples wishing to celebrate the Sacrament of Marriage should contact the parish **at least 6 months** prior to the desired date. Preparation for celebrating and living the sacrament is required. Catholics are to be confirmed prior to celebrating marriage. Contact Roberta Tassani for more information.

ANOIDTING OF THE SICK - is celebrated any time there is a serious illness or health crisis. Contact the parish office to make arrangements.

FUNERALS - Please contact the parish after a death, and before making arrangements with a funeral home.

CONFIRMATION - The Sacrament of Confirmation is celebrated yearly for those who are age 16 or older. Attendance at preparation sessions is required. Contact the Parish office or email kellyg@holyrosaryedmonds.org for information. Adults who have not been confirmed may also celebrate the sacrament, which is a requirement for the Sacrament of Marriage and a prerequisite to be a godparent. Contact Roberta Tassani for information.

FIRST RECONCILIATION/FIRST EUCHARIST - Children are prepared for these sacraments after completing a year of remote preparation in either the school or a religious education program. This is a two-year program; the first year is a general introduction, and the second year being specific preparation. Parents attend preparation sessions for each sacrament. Contact Mary Hupf, Director for Elementary Faith Formation, for more information.

BECOMING CATHOLIC - Adults who wish to join the Catholic Faith participate in sessions of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (R.C.I.A.) Contact the Parish Office for further information.
