Just after the New Year our parish posted and has been interviewing for a Pastoral Administrator Associate (PAA). This position is typical for almost all parishes in the Archdiocese. I am happy to announce that we have filled the position. Ted Krembs, who currently has a similar position in Reno, NV, has accepted the position. An interview committee made up of three parishioners and a Pastoral Administrator from a nearby parish unanimously felt that Ted was the most qualified for the job.

This position will be crucial moving forward to continue and implement the work the Finance Council is doing with budgets, and putting a financial plan and structure in place that will put us on a fiscally sound path. Ted will work closely with me and be responsible for the general administration of the parish which includes budgets, facilities, development, stewardship and supervising administrative staff.

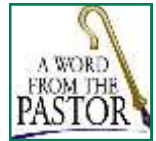
Ted will be coming with his wife Eileen, who is a nurse, and his daughter Theresa who will be entering high school. Ted will start July 1st after he finishes out his present position he has had for the past twelve years. I am looking forward to welcoming him and introducing him in more detail when he arrives. This will also align with the retirement of Lin Lacy who has agreed to move her original March 31st date of retirement to June 30th to accommodate our needs.

The celebration of Centenary of the apparition of Our Lady of Fatima is less than two months away. Our Lady of Fatima is also known as Our Lady of the Rosary. Therefore this feast and apparition of Our Lady of Fatima has a special significance for our parish. I would like to do something to mark and honor this centenary at our parish. Fatima came at a particularly troubled time: WWI was raging across Europe. In April and May I would like to present a two-part series on the history and message of Fatima and the Rosary. We should not miss this opportunity for grace for our parish of Holy Rosary.

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

INFANT BAPTISM - Parents and godparents attend one session to prepare to celebrate this sacrament. We encourage parents to attend before the birth or adoption of their child. Baptisms are normally celebrated at a weekend liturgy on the first or second weekend of the month. Please call the Parish Office at least six weeks prior to the desired Baptism date to register your child. Next preparation class is on April 23rd, 2017, beginning with mass at 11AM ending by 3:00PM. Please call to register. Upcoming baptisms are on Easter Sunday, April 16th, 2017 at 11AM, May 7th at 11AM, June 10th at 5PM and July 9th at 11AM.

MARRIAGE - Couples wishing to celebrate the Sacrament of Marriage should contact the parish at least 6 months prior to the desired date. Preparation for celebrating and living the sacrament is required. Contact Roberta Tassani for more information.

ANointING OF THE SICK - is celebrated any time there is a serious illness or health crisis. Contact the parish office to make arrangements. The sacrament is also celebrated periodically at a Sunday liturgy and on weekdays.

FUNERALS - Please contact the parish after a death, and before making arrangements with a funeral home.

CONFIRMATION - The Sacrament of Confirmation is celebrated yearly for those who are age 16 or older. Attendance at preparation sessions is required. Contact the Parish office for information.

Adults who have not been confirmed may also celebrate the sacrament. Contact Roberta Tassani for information.

FIRST RECONCILIATION/FIRST EUCHARIST - Children are prepared for these sacraments after completing a year of remote preparation in either the school or a religious education program. This is a two-year program; the first year is a general introduction, and the second year being specific preparation. Parents attend preparation sessions for each sacrament. Contact Mary Hupf, Director for Elementary Faith Formation, for more information.

ADULT INITIATION - Adults who wish to join the Catholic Faith participate in sessions of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (R.C.I.A.) Contact the Parish Office for further information.
