Dear Parishioners,

We have lost a dear member of our community, Fr. Joseph Petosa, a good man, a holy priest, a good shepherd. He passed away May 5th. Though he served at many parishes in the Archdiocese we were blessed to have him here at Holy Rosary almost the last two decades of his life. He loved his priesthood; he loved Holy Rosary and the people of Holy Rosary.

We are very happy to host Fr. Petosa’s funeral at Holy Rosary and we will do our best to properly honor Father. Archbishop Sartain will be presiding with some 60 to 70 priests concelebrating.

Fr. Petosa was ordained on May 21, 1955 at St. James Cathedral, Seattle by Archbishop Thomas A. Connolly. He served as Pastor at Our Lady of Perpetual Help, Everett from 1990 to 1994, Assumption Church, Seattle from 1982 to 1988, St. Luke Church, Shoreline 1971-1982 and St. Mary of the Valley Church Monroe from 1966 -1971.

He served as Parochial Vicar at Assumption Church, Seattle from 1988-1990, St. Brendan Church, Bothell from 1965-1966, St. Charles Borromeo Church, Tacoma from 1964-1965 and Seattle Holy Rosary Church, Seattle from 1955-1964. He was most often present here at Holy Rosary Parish in his years as a Senior Priest.

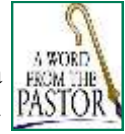
He was a generous priest in every sense in the word and his joyful spirit, even in the midst of physical trials, was infectious. We are grateful to God for his nearly 62 years of service as a priest and his time here at Holy Rosary.

SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

INFANT BAPTISM - Parents and godparents attend one session to prepare to celebrate this sacrament. We encourage parents to attend before the birth or adoption of their child. Baptisms are normally celebrated at a weekend liturgy on the first or second weekend of the month. Please call the Parish Office at least six weeks prior to the desired Baptism date to register your child. Next preparation class is on July 30th, 2017 beginning with mass at 11AM ending by 3:00PM. Please call the Parish Office to register. Upcoming baptisms are on June 10th at 5PM, July 9th at 11AM, August 5th at 5PM and September 3rd at 11AM.

MARRIAGE - Couples wishing to celebrate the Sacrament of Marriage should contact the parish at least 6 months prior to the desired date. Preparation for celebrating and living the sacrament is required. Contact Roberta Tassani for more information.

ANointING OF THE SICK - is celebrated any time there is a serious illness or health crisis. Contact the parish office to make arrangements. The sacrament is also celebrated periodically at a Sunday liturgy and on weekdays.

FUNERALS - Please contact the parish after a death, and before making arrangements with a funeral home.

CONFIRMATION - The Sacrament of Confirmation is celebrated yearly for those who are age 16 or older. Attendance at preparation sessions is required. Contact the Parish office for information.

Adults who have not been confirmed may also celebrate the sacrament. Contact Roberta Tassani for information.

FIRST RECONCILIATION/FIRST EUCHARIST - Children are prepared for these sacraments after completing a year of remote preparation in either the school or a religious education program. This is a two-year program; the first year is a general introduction, and the second year being specific preparation. Parents attend preparation sessions for each sacrament. Contact Mary Hupf, Director for Elementary Faith Formation, for more information.

ADULT INITIATION - Adults who wish to join the Catholic Faith participate in sessions of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (R.C.I.A.) Contact the Parish Office for further information.
