

Solemnity of Corpus Christi

Dear Parishioners,

St. Justin Martyr, whose feast day we celebrated on Friday, laid out one of the earliest descriptions of the Mass in his First Apology, written between 153 and 155 A.D. It is remarkable that already in the 2nd Century the Early Christian community had developed the lines and main elements of the Mass as we celebrate the Eucharist today, two millennia later. Since today is the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, the Body and Blood of Christ, I thought it appropriate that we hear from St. Justin Martyr, an early source:

“And this food is called among us Eucharistia [the Eucharist], of which no one is allowed to partake but those who believes that the things which we teach are true, and who has been washed with the washing that is for the remission of sins, and unto regeneration, and who is so living as Christ has enjoined.

For not as common bread and common drink do we receive these; but in like manner as Jesus Christ our Saviour, having been made flesh by the Word of God, had both flesh and blood for our salvation, so likewise have we been taught that the food which is blessed by the prayer of His word, and from which our blood and flesh by transmutation are nourished, is the flesh and blood of that Jesus who was made flesh.” - (*First Apology*, 66)

We see in the 2nd Century that those who participated in the Eucharist were baptized and were committed to living as Christ enjoined. There is also a clear understanding in this passage of the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist that through the Eucharist we are transformed, “transmuted” or “metabolized”, into Christ.

As we celebrate this great Solemnity of Corpus Christi, might you consider committing to spending an hour a week before our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament? We can always use more adorers and my goal is eventually to have 24/7 adoration with exposition. If you are an adorer or would like to be an adorer please join us for an adorers meeting June 7th at 7PM in the School Hall. We have some special assignments for our adoration community.

I think something that St. Elizabeth of the Trinity said about her mission can actually be realized through time spent in adoration in the presence of the Eucharist. This quote from her that I gave in last Sunday’s homily is apt: “I think that in Heaven my mission will be to draw souls by helping them to go out of themselves in order to cling to God by a wholly simple and loving movement, and to keep them in this great silence within which allows God to communicate Himself to them and to transform them into Himself.”

YOUTH MINISTRY



SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

INFANT BAPTISM - Parents and godparents attend one session to prepare to celebrate this sacrament. We encourage parents to attend before the birth or adoption of their child. Please call the Parish Office at least **six weeks prior to the desired Baptism date** to register your child. **Next preparation class** is on **July 22nd, 2018 beginning with Mass at 11AM and ending by 2:30PM**. Please call the Parish Office to register. Upcoming baptisms are on **June 10th, July 8th, and August 12, 2018**. Baptisms are scheduled with Father Vincent on the ***second Sunday of the month, after the 11AM Mass***. Parishioners who prefer to have the Baptism at “their” regular mass time may make that request through the parish office.

MARRIAGE - Couples wishing to celebrate the Sacrament of Marriage should contact the parish at **least 6 months** prior to the desired date. Preparation for celebrating and living the sacrament is required. Catholics are to be confirmed prior to celebrating marriage. Contact Roberta Tassani for more information.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK - is celebrated any time there is a serious illness or health crisis. Contact the parish office to make arrangements.

FUNERALS - Please contact the parish after a death, and before making arrangements with a funeral home.

CONFIRMATION - The Sacrament of Confirmation is celebrated yearly for those who are age 16 or older. Attendance at preparation sessions is required. Contact the Parish office or email kellyg@holyrosaryedmonds.org for information. Adults who have not been confirmed may also celebrate the sacrament, which is a requirement for the Sacrament of Marriage and a prerequisite to be a godparent. Contact Roberta Tassani for information.

FIRST RECONCILIATION/FIRST EUCHARIST - Children are prepared for these sacraments after completing a year of remote preparation in either the school or a religious education program. This is a two-year program; the first year is a general introduction, and the second year being specific preparation. Parents attend preparation sessions for each sacrament. Contact Mary Hupf, Director for Elementary Faith Formation, for more information.

BECOMING CATHOLIC - Adults who wish to join the Catholic Faith participate in sessions of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (R.C.I.A.) Contact the Parish Office for further information or email becomingCatholic@holyrosaryedmonds.org.
